Parents and/or students the 2023 Grandmont Scholarship Application Process is officially underway. To be considered for one of the scholarships the Grandmont Community Association Scholarship Committee has allotted for 2023, please carefully, review the instructions below. As stated earlier, our vision is to enhance the education of our youth by awarding scholarships. To continue this effort, parents, we need your support in assisting your graduating senior in meeting the **June 30th** deadline.

Your role in this process as a parent is to:

- ✓ Support and encourage your child to apply for the scholarship;
- ✓ Make certain your child is eligible by assisting them with completing all requirements;
- ✓ Serve as a good proofreader for their essay;
- ✓ Check to make sure that all documents are copied and submitted by **June 30th**.

DIRECTIONS FOR COMPLETING THE 2023 GRANDMONT SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION PROCESS:

- ◆ A one or two page (typed) autobiographical essay which includes career objective, personal goals, educational plans and any important information concerning why you should be considered;
- ◆ List of awards and achievements;
- ◆ Two (2) letters of recommendation on letterhead from a teacher, counselor, community leader, coach, mentor, advisor, minister, or employer;
- ◆ Copy of high school transcript;
- ◆ Copy of report card

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS: All applicants must:

- ◆ Be active in the Grandmont Community. **Parents must be active as well.**
- ◆ Have paid dues to the Grandmont Community Association for the past three consecutive years. However, the previous dues payments are waived for new residents.
- ◆ Have a cumulative G.P.A. of 3.0 or better.
- ◆ Be accepted at a post-secondary institution. Verification will be requested.
- ◆ Be interviewed by the GCA Scholarship Committee.

DID YOU KNOW?

The application filing period is July 1 thru September 15. The City of Detroit may provide a discount to homeowners who are at least 65 years old and have a household gross income below \$40,000. Effective July 1, 2009, the Solid Waste Fee is \$240. Qualifying Seniors will receive a discount of \$120.

YOU MUST SUBMIT A NEW APPLICATION EVERY YEAR DURING THE FILING PERIOD.

File the application with the City of Detroit Treasurer's Office by September 15, 2023.

- In Person** - Citizen Tax Help Center, Coleman A. Young Municipal Center, Room 136.
- By Mail** - City of Detroit, Citizen Tax Help Center, Coleman A. Young Municipal Center, 2 Woodward Avenue, Room 136, Detroit, MI 48226

- Proof of your identity, address, and age (valid driver's license, passport, or other government issued photo ID)
- Proof of your income (last year's State of Michigan Property Tax Credit Form, State Tax Return, or a notarized affidavit of income form (a mandatory notarized & signed affidavit form if you don't have the 1040 forms is needed for this discount).
