

Qualifications for the High School Scholarship:

Parent(s)/Guardian(s) are expected to meet the following requirements:

- Required to have paid a total of \$90 in membership dues to the Grandmont Community Association, covering a three-year period. The dues are \$30 per year and are per address/household, not individually.
- Attend a minimum of one Grandmont Community Association Board/Community Meeting within the 2025 Scholarship period covering April 2024-March 2025.
- Volunteer at a community event or join a committee within the 2025 Scholarship period covering April 2024-March 2025.

Applicant is expected to meet the following requirements:

- Have a cumulative G.P.A. of 2.5 or better.
- Submit verification of acceptance at a post-secondary institution. (Verification is required).
- Volunteer at least 20 hours of community service within the 2025 Scholarship period covering April 2024-March 2025. (Verification will be required). *Volunteer hours must be completed prior to submitting application packet.
- Attend required scholarship session.

Applicant must complete the GCA Scholarship Application and submit the following documents:

- A 500-1000 word (typed) autobiographical essay which includes career objective, personal goals, educational plans, and any important information addressing why you should be considered.
- Resume with list of awards and achievements.
- Two (2) letters of recommendation on letterhead from a High School teacher or counselor, educational or community organization leader, coach, mentor, advisor, minister, or employer.
- Submit Official High school transcript.
- Submit proof of acceptance to a post-secondary institution.
- Submit proof of income - Attach one of the following: 2023 Household W-2, housing voucher, SNAP, WIC, Medicaid, free lunch voucher.
